THE THREE DIMENSIONS

What Every Leader Must Develop

01 Emotional Maturity

The discipline to regulate yourself before you attempt to lead the room. Immaturity reacts — maturity responds.

02 Relational Maturity

The willingness to honor people, repair trust, and communicate with dignity. Authority becomes human when people feel seen, heard, and respected.

03 Personal Maturity

The humility to own your part, accept feedback, and keep growing. A title is not proof that development is finished.
